



Medical Certificates

Please find below recommended Medical Examiners. Every pilot requires a medical certificate in order to be able to exercise the privileges of their licence.

EASA (European Licence):

A Class 2 is required for private operations, or class 1 if operating commercial.

FAA (US Licence):

Under FAA a pilot is required to hold a class 3 medical certificate if operating privately; this includes for student pilots flying solo. If operating commercial a class 2 or perhaps even a 1 is required.
